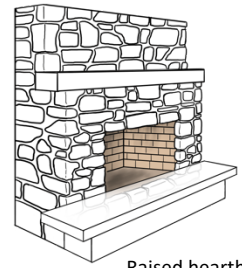
Hole in the wall –

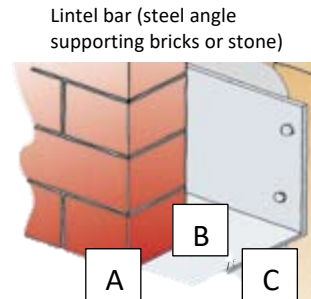
Step 1: Measure the fireplace width (brick to brick/marble to marble/stone to stone)
